CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Comic Book: Become a published author! Come with a story, do it in your style, and be published and on AMAZON.COM. Everyone gets 2 free copies & more if they like. Books may be ready by the end of the camp program. *If you need more time, take the afternoon drawing class & work on your comic then.

Art Buffet: EVERY CLASS IS DIFFERENT, projects will not repeat. You can take EVERY art buffet class. If weather is mild we sometimes paint along the Delaware River, just 2 blocks from the gallery or other local historic sites. Projects may include painting, drawing, sculpture and much more.

Cartooning: Learn to make original characters, create comic strips and Flip-Book Animations.

Sculpture: Create works of art in 3-D. Use stone-like materials, wood, metal and many other possibilities. It can be a bit messy so bring a smock! Take both!

Drawing, Painting, Illustration: Learn the techniques of the old masters, cover the basics and experiment with materials in ways you never thought possible. Students will work in a wide variety of media. If weather is good we may go outdoors to work at local sights & Delaware River.

Our program: A day camp held at the Firehouse Gallery of Bordentown, in the heart of the historic district and hugged by the Delaware River. Art classes have been held here for more than 38 years, 16 years under the current owner.

Security: We hire only certified NJ Art Teachers, not crafters. All must pass a F.B.I. background check. Eric Gibbons, the owner and director, has been internationally published for his art lessons and has his own artwork in collections around the globe. You cannot find a better & experienced staff!

Cost: CHECKS payable to "FIREHOUSE GALLERY" \$125 for a week of half days. \$250 for a week of full day classes with a 1 hour supervised lunch (Students bring their own lunch). ALL supplies are included. Each class meets daily for 3 hours for a week. Classes are reserved with payment. Always call after MAY 1 to see if the classes you desire are full. We offer NO REFUNDS unless a class is full, but we can switch classes if space permits.
